Peter Herzog was elected to his first term on the Lake Forest City Council in November of 1994. He was then selected as Mayor for 1998 and again in 1999. Council Member Herzog helped guide the annexation of the Lake Forest Sphere of Influence to the City. He has been frequently asked to speak statewide on LAFCO and legislation affecting local government. Mr. Herzog serves on LAFCO's Legislative Committee and Budget Committee.

The 58 LAFCOs statewide have chosen Mr. Herzog to serve on the Board of Directors of the California Association of LAFCOs (CALAFCO). In that position, he works on policies and legislation that affects LAFCOs throughout the state.

Council Member Herzog serves on various committees for the League of California Cities, including its Executive Steering Committee and is the current Second Vice President. He is a Charter Member of the Lake Forest Kiwanis Club.
