CURRENT TERM OF OFFICE: 2014 - 2018

Commissioner Brothers, Mayor of the City of Fountain Valley, was first appointed to OC LAFCO by the City Selection Committee as an alternate in 2013 and became a regular member in 2014.

Commissioner Brothers grew up in Los Alamitos and has lived in Orange County most of her life. She was a stay at home mom for many years, volunteering in PTA programs and children's activities such as scouts.

She was selected to be a member of the Orange County Grand Jury in 1992-93; and since 1993, has served as a member of the Orange County Grand Jurors Association Board of Directors. This year of service deepened an interest in Orange County governance. In 1995, Cheryl was on staff for former Orange County Supervisor Charles Smith and retired from the County when he left office in 2008.

Commissioner Brothers was appointed to the Fountain Valley Parks and Recreation Commission in 1987 and served for 9 years. She left that commission when she was appointed to the Planning Commission in 1996, where she helped shape development in Fountain Valley for 6 years. Commissioner Brothers was elected to the Fountain Valley city council in 2002-06 and 2006-10; elected back to the city council in 2012. She has served on the following Boards and Commissions:
