CURRENT TERM OF OFFICE: 2014 - 2018

Commissioner Todd Spitzer, a former California State Assembly Member and the current Orange County Supervisor for the Third District, was first appointed to OC LAFCO in 2013 as an alternate and became a regular member in 2014.

Commissioner Spitzer has dedicated his career to public service. A former high school teacher, reserve police officer and prosecutor, he understands the challenges facing everyday people. First elected to public office in 1992, Commissioner Spitzer is dedicated to enhancing public safety, strengthening fiscal responsibility and improving vital infrastructure. He has a long record of advocating for public safety and led the successful campaign to pass Marsy's Law for All, the nation's most comprehensive victims' Bill of Rights.

Commissioner Spitzer also serves on the Association of California Cities - Orange County of Orange, Emergency Management Council, OC Public Libraries Advisory Board, Orange County Community Corrections Partnership, Orange County Criminal Justice Coordinating Council, Orange County Fire Authority, Orange County Flood Control, Orange County Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council, Orange County Transportation Authority, Santa Ana River Flood Protection Agency, Santa Ana River Trail and Parkway Partnership and Transportation Corridor Agency - Foothills/Eastern and San Joaquin Hills.

Commissioner Spitzer has been the recipient of numerous recognitions for his service. In 2005, **Crime Victims United of California** named Assemblyman Spitzer "Legislator of the Year." In 2004, the **California Coalition Against Sexual Assault** named him its "Legislator of the Year," citing his extensive work with Megan's Law and his dedication to protecting victims of sexual assault.
