

OC LAFCO Commissioner Compensation

The compensation for Commissioners is governed by the OC LAFCO Bylaws (Section 1.20). The following specifies the types and amounts of compensation as defined in the Bylaws:

- Each member in attendance at any Commission regular or special meeting, shall receive a stipend of \$100 per meeting, up to a maximum of \$200 per month.
- Members appointed to committees shall receive \$50 for attendance at committee meetings, or half the amount paid for attendance at Commission meetings. However, the maximum amount paid to any commissioner in a given month shall not exceed \$200.
- Members will be reimbursed at the currently applicable IRS rates for reasonable and necessary mileage expenses incurred for meeting attendance and other Commission business, including committee meetings and CALAFCO functions.
- Commissioners attending CALAFCO functions (i.e., conferences, workshops, executive board meetings) shall be compensated for the expenses associated with conference registration, accommodations, parking, mileage, and car rental. Commissioners shall not receive a stipend for attending such functions. However, if a Commissioner serves as a CALAFCO Board Member, he/she shall receive a stipend for attending CALAFCO Executive Board meetings.
- Commissioners are not employees of LAFCO and are not eligible for any employee benefits.
