WHEREAS, Commissioner Charley Wilson has served with distinction as a member of the Orange County Local Agency Formation Commission since May 2001; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Wilson, one of the longest-serving Commissioners in the history of Orange County LAFCO, has been a key participant in many significant accomplishments of this Commission, including, but not limited to:

- Annexations to the Orange County Sanitary District
- Orange Park Acres Annexation to Irvine Ranch Water District
- Merger of Coastal Municipal Water District with Municipal Water District of Orange County
- Signal Landmark Reorganization to the City of Huntington Beach
- Tonner Hills Annexation to the City of Brea
- Annexation of over 50 unincorporated islands
- Preparation of multiple South Orange County governance reports and studies
- Implementation of the Shared Services and Fiscal Trends Web-based Programs
- Three cycles of agency Sphere of Influence Updates and Municipal Service Reviews
