

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

### **LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION of ORANGE COUNTY (OC LAFCO)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by OC LAFCO to consider the proposed **“Hamer Island Annexation to the City of Placentia” (IA 22-02)**.

The City of Placentia has filed an application with OC LAFCO to consider the annexation of the Hamer Unincorporated Island. Located in the northeast portion of the City’s sphere of influence, the Hamer Island is completely surrounded by Placentia and is generally located north of East Palm Drive and west of Rose Drive. The purpose of the proposed annexation is to establish a more logical boundary and support the efficient delivery of municipal services to the residents of the island.

The hearing will be held on Wednesday, June 8, 2022, beginning at 8:15 a.m. at the Planning Commission Hearing Room, Hall of Administration, 333. W Santa Ana Blvd., 10 Civic Center Plaza, Santa Ana, CA 92701. At the hearing, the Commission will consider oral and written testimony by any interested person or affected agency and the report of the Executive Officer. In accordance with Government Code Section 56375.3(a), the Commission shall approve, after notice and hearing, the annexation and waive protest proceedings.

Pursuant to Public Resources Code, Section 21067, the City of Placentia is the lead agency for the proposed annexation and approved a Notice of Exemption in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). As a responsible agency, OC LAFCO will review and consider the adoption of environmental findings in accordance with CEQA for the proposed annexation.
