

NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING

LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION OF ORANGE COUNTY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission of Orange County (OC LAFCO) to collect written protests to the **“Activation of Latent Powers for Three Arch Bay Community Services District (LP 25-02).”**

On February 11, 2026, OC LAFCO approved the activation of latent powers for park and recreation services within the Three Arch Bay Community Services District (Three Arch Bay CSD) service boundary. The provision of park and recreation services would include lifeguard services, maintenance of recreation facilities such as the park, sports court, and beach, and organization of community recreation programs within Three Arch Bay CSD. The District is located in the southern part of the City of Laguna Beach, with a service boundary encompassing 147.2 acres. The purpose of the application is for the District to provide park and recreation services to its residents.

Pursuant to Government Code Sections 57000 and 57002, OC LAFCO will conduct protest proceedings for the proposed activation of latent powers, and a protest hearing will be held making determinations on the protests filed with OC LAFCO. The hearing will be held on **April 20, 2026 at 9:00 a.m.** at the **Local Agency Formation Commission of Orange County, 2677 North Main Street, Suite 1050, Conference Room, Santa Ana, CA 92705.**

Any registered voter or landowner residing within the Three Arch Bay Community Services District boundary may file a written protest from **Wednesday, March 18, 2026** through the end of the Protest Hearing held on **Monday, April 20, 2026.** Each written protest must contain the requirements specified in Government Code Section 57051. Written protests may be mailed or filed in person any time prior to the close of the Protest Hearing on **Monday, April 20, 2026,** and should be addressed to: **Luis Tapia, Executive Officer, 2677 N.
